MANAGER COMMENTARY
Market Overview

The recovery in financial markets continued in the third quarter with the MSCI Emerging Markets Small Mid Cap Index rising by 9.2% during the quarter. The economic environment in our geographies showed a steady improvement from the bottom in terms of activity, which took place at the beginning of the second quarter. Continued level of support for employment programs has so far reduced the impact in many of our geographies. In spite of significant political risks (U.S. election, final Brexit negotiation, geopolitical tension with China, incipient second wave of COVID) in our geographies the leading fundamental indicators we follow indicate a tentative positive direction for economic activity in most industries.

During the September Federal Reserve meeting, Chairman Powell reiterated the Federal Reserve's commitment to maintaining easy monetary conditions until inflation is sustainably above 2%. Chairman Powell also encouraged an increase in fiscal stimulus. After decades of reliance on monetary stimulus, the US economy and capital markets suffer from excess leverage, malinvestment and structural imbalances that hamper the effectiveness of monetary tools. Post the election, regardless of the outcome, we expect fiscal policy in close coordination with the Federal Reserve to take center stage in driving economic growth.

The last bout of loose fiscal policy was combined with tight monetary policy, which sustained U.S. Dollar strength. The next round of loose fiscal policy will likely be combined with loose monetary policy, which will pressure the U.S. Dollar. Should such economic policy be pursued, and successfully increase nominal GDP growth, it will represent a fundamental shift in the underlying economic conditions that have not been witnessed in years. Such a shift in the economic environment will likely lead to increased market volatility and broad changes in market leadership.

Portfolio Positioning

As a result of buys and sells and market action, our weightings in India and Indonesia increased during the quarter. The portfolio's weighting in France, Singapore, Taiwan, and the United Kingdom decreased during the quarter.

From a sector perspective, our weightings in Materials, Information Technology, Consumer Staples, and Communication increased during the quarter. The portfolio's weighting in Financials, Utilities, and Real Estate decreased during the period.

Contributors to Performance

During the quarter, the portfolio experienced strong absolute performance which was roughly in line with the MSCI Emerging Markets Small Mid Benchmark. The fund returned 9.2% during the third quarter compared to the MSCI Emerging Markets Small Mid Index's increase of 9.4%. The strategy had positive contribution from stock selection but was offset by allocation effect. The best performing countries (total effect) were Brazil, India, Singapore, Thailand, and South Africa. The portfolio underperformed in Taiwan, China, Malaysia, Mexico, and Saudi Arabia. The portfolio continues to be overweight information technology and consumer discretionary while underweight to health care, financials, consumer staples, and materials.

Outlook

We have added nine new companies and fully exited six during the quarter, which is in line with a normal turnover range, after a very active first quarter. We continue to see a level of opportunities within the opportunity set that is exciting and almost unprecedented. While we have experienced a V-shaped recovery in financial assets through the summer from the March lows, we still see a slow and gradual recovery as imbalances and unintended consequences are addressed.

COMPOSITE DESCRIPTION. Effective 10/1/2019, this composite is comprised of all fee-paying, discretionary Emerging Markets Opportunities portfolios in excess of \$1 million under management. Prior to 10/1/19, the composite consisted of all non-restricted, fully discretionary, taxable and tax-exempt accounts which were managed in accordance with the Emerging Markets Opportunities strategy at Advisory Research, Inc. The Emerging Markets Opportunities strategy primarily invests in non-U.S. equities and principally in emerging markets with a market capitalization generally within the range of the MSCI Emerging Markets SMID Cap Index. The MSCI Emerging Markets SMID Cap Index captures mid and small cap representation across 26 Emerging Markets countries. With 2,276 constituents, the index covers approximately 29% of the free float-adjusted market capitalization in each country. Emerging Markets Opportunities countries include Argentina, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Czech Republic, Egypt, Greece, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Mexico, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Qatar, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey and United Arab Emirates. OTHER NOTES. Performance results are presented before management fees. Results for the full historical period are time weighted. Accounts have been valued daily and portfolio returns have been weighted by using beginning-of-month market values plus daily weighted cash flow. Inception date is 11/30/13. The dispersion calculation is based on a dollar-weighted average of portfolios within the composite for the entire period. The dispersion percent of N/A indicates that the number of portfolios for the entire year were equal to five or fewer or periods of less than one year. The benchmark source is FactSet. The valuation source is Intercontinental Exchange (ICE) through Advent Software. Benchmark returns are not covered by the report of independent verifiers.

Portfolios meeting the stated criteria are added to the composite as of the first full quarter of investment in that composite's style. Similarly, accounts are removed from the composite after the last full quarter of management under the composite style. A complete list and descriptions of composites is available upon request. The composite results portrayed reflect the reinvestment of dividends, capital gains, and other earnings when appropriate. The U.S. dollar is the currency used to express performance.

CALCULATION METHODOLOGY. The composite performance results are time-weighted total returns net of commissions and transaction costs. Valuations and returns are expressed in U.S. dollars. Vaughan Nelson consistently values all portfolios each month on a trade date basis. Additional information regarding policies for valuing portfolios, calculating performance, and preparing compliant presentations are available upon request. No composite accounts hold foreign denominated securities. Net-of-fee returns are calculated utilizing the highest annual fee paid by a client in the strategy. This fee is divided by 12 and subtracted from the gross composite return on a monthly basis to calculate monthly net of fee returns. Quarterly and annual net-of-fee returns are calculated by geometrically linking these monthly returns.

COMPLIANT STATEMENT. Vaughan Nelson claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS® Standards. Vaughan Nelson has been independently verified for the periods 12/31/97 through 6/30/20.
